# Chair's report

- November 25 was the AGM, elections took place and new positions are listed above
- Thanks to former ORWC chair, Sister Linda Koenders, for her service
- Possible Polytechnique massacre of 14 women
- January 21 Women's March on Washington took place in Ottawa, where approximately 8000 people were in attendance; awesome feedback

Guest speaker – <u>Emilie Taman</u> is the candidate for the NDP party in a yet-to-be-announced by-election in Ottawa-Vanier federal riding. Emilie is also a part-time University of Ottawa law professor. She provided animated and informative insights into her political experiences, including touching on her famous mother, Louise Arbour, UN human rights judge and Canadian Supreme Court justice. We were able to engage with her in a Q&A session afterwards.

- Women still make up the largest % of precarious workers
- Lack of women is apparent at all levels, 4 only on city council, less than 50% representation among MPs and MPPs

#### Three main priorities/issues are:

- 2015 amendments to EI to extend it to 18 months for parental leave
- The continued absence of a national childcare program (cost, availability, progress)
- P CPP enhancement current changes are not good for women because it eliminates the provision to zero out low income years and increase average
