Women in Leadership

- Campaigns Sister Renelle presented a 3 minute candidate speech to discuss herself and her platform for OAC; the committee discussed and provided feedback, and discussed ways to support women candidates
- Public speaking discussed options for practising public speaking, including speech craft program
- Comedy discussed comedy camp for women, run by a local woman
- There is also social media training available, ORWC has a FaceBook page

Motion from Sister Grace Morgan – so long as there are no other barriers of which we are unaware, I move that ORWC cover the registration fee for up to two sisters at Triennial Convention as observers. Seconded by Kira Turner, carried.
