## YWC Resolution Update – Term of Reference

A.Silas in favour with the shift but suggested meeting bi-monthly. A trial period was discussed, followed by a meeting to update the bylaws. T. T.Shapransky proposed young workers and the committee get involve through plant gates during the strike vote period.

A.Grondin proposed the YWC committee present at conventions on work done by YWC. The length of presentation is 10 -15 min followed by time for questions. The purpose of the meeting to provide an overview and inspire other people in the community. Presentation can showcase work done – texting campaign, call hub particular to demographic and community. T.Shapransky expressed interest.

A.Proulx advised everyone is encouraged to vote yes to the strike vote. The goal is to bring Treasury Board back to the table. Those unable to picket can come to PSAC office to make posters.
