April 28th / #10for10

PSAC-NCR participated in Ontario-wide and local organizing for the #10for10 campaign calling on 10 employer-provided paid sick days for all workers. Prepared francophone materials for the campaign. Collaborated with OCAF (Ottawa Coalition Against Ford) and other labour allies for Ottawa-area organizing.

May Day

Participated in local organizing with TROCAO and Justice 4 Workers Ottawa / OCAF.

TROCAO (Table régionale des organismes communautaires autonomes de l'Outaouais) organizing led to a rally/press conference in Gatineau which was also diffused online.
