1. CALL TO ORDER

Co-Chair Brother Gabriel called the meeting to order.

4. GCWCC Youth Engagement Campaign

Tasha offered to help our committee engage and rebuild through the lessons learned from her engagement campaign for the GCWCC. We must solidify our value proposition centered around educating young members on their rights, where they come from and create spaces to engage them in discussing which rights we cherish most as well as those we should seek to establish. We need to disseminate this value proposition through partnerships (YPN, Community groups, etc.), a digital strategy which leverages existing electronic channels of partners and digital influencers, and a vision which allows us to align our work in a way which makes us relevant to desired partners.

Summarizing this discussion was very difficult, but it generated tons of ideas for each member present and will fuel future discussions around engagement. We were all very thankful to Tasha for leading this discussion and look forward to working with her in the future.

5. YWC Background and past events

Gabriel gave an overview of the 2 young worker conferences held in the NCR (2011 and 2013), the Leadership course we created and delivered in 2012, our involvement with broader events such as Powershift in 2012 and the Peoples Social Forum in 2014, and the 2 videos we produced. Gabriel took personal responsibility for the lack of activity over the past 3 years and looks forward to supporting engaged members in forging the future of this body.

Rhea will be ironing out the details of a communication plan for engaging our distribution list and network to tweet their MP in support of a national daycare program.

Gabriel elaborated on the objectives of this working group composed of a representative from every region's young workers committee. Lately, the discussions have been mainly to organize around resolutions for convention season which is coming up. Both Matthew and Rhea are to be engaged in future dealings with this body.
